Called to Order: 7:30 pm

Mr. Stephens passed his septic installer's test and received his permit.

Ms. Laflamme (Tubbs) and **Mr. Giddings** reported possible health violations at the Indian Plaza. Among their concerns are: trash, including appliances and bathroom fixtures, piled where the dumpster used to be and at the top of the hill. An unregistered car parked out front; two unregistered trucks with trash stored within them, a damaged camper, other campers and trailers which had not been removed. The Board will investigate. They expressed a desire to attend any future joint meetings with the Select and Planning Boards and Harold and Sharon Roberts.

Mr. Bowen picked up permits for Woodland Park. He updated the Board on the status of the Park's septic plan. He reported a meeting with DEP. They are going to get back to **Mr. Bowen's** engineer on some issues discussed at the meeting. The Board will contact DEP to determine the status of their review of the plans and their understanding of what still needs to be done in order to finalize the plans and begin construction. The Board will contact **Mr. Bowen** before the January 10, 2007 meeting to determine whether or not it makes sense for him to come to that meeting so that the Board can make an informed decision on January 24, 2007 on further extensions on the deadline to complete the Title V repairs at Woodland Park. **Mr. Bowen** expressed an interest in the Board seat formerly held by **Mary St. Germain**.

The Board discussed with **Mr. Stephens** his septic plan. Action was postponed until January 10, 2007.

The Board received Title V reports for the two houses and pavilion on Warfield Road owned by **John Glaze**. All three systems failed.
