### FY 2012 Financial warrant articles

#### Audit Fund

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or otherwise provide, the sum of \$5,000 for the FY 2012 Audit Fund, or take any other action relative thereto.

#### Assessor's Revaluation Fund

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or otherwise provide, the sum of \$6,355 for the FY 2012 Assessor's Revaluation Fund, or take any other action relative thereto.

#### Open Space/Agricultural Preservation

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or otherwise provide, the sum of \$2,500 to be added to the Open Space/Agricultural Preservation account set up in 2000 for the purpose of a local match for the Agricultural Preservation Restriction Program or other similar conservation programs, or take any other action relative thereto.

#### 3 Town Landfill Payment

To see if the Town will vote to transfer from its Fund Balance Reserved for Landfill Debt Account the sum of \$62,500 to be used for the FY12 interest and principal due on the Tri-Town Landfill debt, or take any other action relative thereto.

#### Dog Revolving Fund

To see if the Town will vote pursuant to the provisions of Section 53E1/2 of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, to authorize the establishment of a Dog Fund revolving account for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011. Revenue sources for this fund will come from dog license fees and other charges as provided by Chapter 40, S. 147A. The funds will be used by the Town Clerk and Animal Control Officer to offset expenses related to administration of licenses and other animal control matters. The maximum amount that may be spent from the fund for fiscal year 2012 is limited to \$2,500.

#### Hawlemont Preschool

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or otherwise provide a sum of money in the amount of \$8,500.00 for the purpose of paying certain costs associated with the Hawlemont preschool program or take any action relating there to.

#### Highway Plow

Warrant articles 2012

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate, borrow or transfer \$6,000 to purchase a new 11 foot shoulder plow for the Highway Department, or take any other action relative thereto.

Wire West Cooperative membership

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate an amount not to exceed \$1000 to be used at the discretion of the selectboard as the joining fee to become a member of the Wire West municipal cooperative, or take any other action relative thereto.

Town Hall Roof

To see if the Town will vote to (are be borrowing?) \$170,000 to replace the roof on the Town Hall, or take any other action relative thereto.
