- Article: 1 To see if the Town will approve the **\$ 0.00** debt authorized by the Mohawk Trail Regional School District (the “District”) on **Wednesday, August 10, 2011**, to pay costs of replacing the roof at the **Buckland-Shelburne Elementary School**, which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve assets that are otherwise capable of supporting the District’s required educational program. The Town acknowledges that the Massachusetts School Building Authority’s (“MSBA”) grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any costs the District incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the District and its member towns, and that any grant that the District may receive from the MSBA for the Projects shall not exceed the lesser of (1) 63.25 percent (63.25%) of eligible, approved project costs, as determined by the MSBA, or (2) the total maximum grant amount determined by the MSBA; and that the amount of borrowing authorized pursuant to the vote of the District described above shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the District and the MSBA. Or take any other action relative thereto.
- Article: 2 To see if the Town will approve the **\$ 0.00** debt authorized by the Mohawk Trail Regional School District (the “District”) on **Wednesday, August 10, 2011**, to pay costs of roof and window replacement at the **Colrain Central School** which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve assets that are otherwise capable of supporting the District’s required educational program. educational program.
