

**MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
Town of Charlemont**

September 5, 2009

The meeting was convened at 10:00 P.M. by Chairman Jean Brisson. Also attending the meeting were Paul Fantucchio and Winston Healy.

1. Mr. Fantucchio reported that he, Dan Hall, and David Gagne had met on Thursday, September 3, 2009. During this meeting Mr. Gagne reported that the well at 279 Avery Brook Road was not sealed and that ground water was entering the well through the sides. Mr. Gagne feels that if the well is sealed off, shocked, and then tested, the water will only need a charcoal filter and the aerator will not be necessary. The quoted cost would be \$2,500.
2. Mr. Fantucchio reported that if sealing the well does not work, the next step to consider would be to drill the well deeper.
3. The Board unanimously voted to move forward with sealing the well. Mr. Fantucchio will inform Mr. Gagne and the Heath and Hawley Selectmen of the decision.
4. Mr. Healy submitted a letter from the Franklin County Tech School's Superintendent. The letter informs the Selectmen that a high school student has moved into the Town and has just applied to the Tech. The student is a junior. The letter states that the Tech School will stand behind their application deadline of April 1<sup>st</sup> but goes on to state that the sending District's (Mohawk) Superintendent has the authority to accept or deny the application. The Board was asked to encourage Superintendent Buoniconti's to support the application. A motion to ask Superintendent Buoniconti to permit the student to attend the Franklin County Technical School was defeated.
5. Business being concluded the meeting was adjourned at 10:40 A.M.
