## CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE MEEETING – CHARLEMONT TOWN HALL

January 12, 2018

Present: Tracy Hall, Ron Smith, Tony Walker; also present – Town Administrator Peg Dean

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 9:12 a.m. by the Chair, Tracy Hall.
- 2. Michael Walsh, Emergency Management Director, appeared to discuss his capital requests. As for the sandbags, there was a question as to how the bags would be filled in an emergency. Would there be enough volunteers to fill thousands of bags? In any case, Michael said the bags were a "low priority" as far as he was concerned. The containers, since the cost is well under \$5,000/year, can be handled through the regular department budget. They might also be purchased through a successful EMPG grant award. As for the generator, a needs assessment needs to be conducted, and Mike will get back to us on that. Mike Walsh and the Interim Fire Chief Dennis Annear, will assess the space needs of a new fire station and where it could be possibly located. The CIC will also be involved in the study.
- 3. New Interim Fire Chief Dennis Annear appeared to review his Department's budget requests. For the Brush Truck request, it is hoped to get a grant award to cover most of the cost, but the Town would have to contribute \$10,000 toward the cost. Jaws of Life: the old ones will not cut through some of the new car materials, meaning we new a new set. There are two requests for the equipment for a total cost of \$30,000. A grant is in the works, and if awarded, we would have to cover 5% of the cost. Dennis is suggesting we budget now for one tool at the full cost of \$15,000, in case the grant is not approved. A suggestion was made that the Town should look at more grant opportunities. Thermal Imagers: it was agreed to put that request off for now, as the present ones seem to work. Defibrillators: there was a Committee question of how much for just one? Engine #2 replacement: Dennis thinks the projected price of a new truck is "too low". He will check on the size needs of a new truck.
- 4. Next CIC meeting: January 17 at 6:00 p.m.
- 5. Review of minutes of the January 3, 2018 meeting: correction to item #7, insert "the radar sign" after "fix". Minutes were approved as corrected.
- 6. The meeting was adjourned at 11:38 a.m.
