## The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM.

- 1. Minutes from the 6/3/15 and 7/1/15 meetings were reviewed and signed.
- 2. Harker made a motion to table the issue of reducing the required Commission membership to five until the 9/2 meeting. This was seconded by Reynolds, and unanimously approved.
- 3. A wetland restoration plan submitted by Bill Latrell of behalf of Anthony and Gisela Walker was reviewed. Reynolds made a motion to accept Latrell's report that restoration has been completed and the enforcement order of 7/10/13 has been fulfilled". This was seconded by Forbes, and unanimously approved. The Commission will send a letter to the Walkers indicating that the project is no longer under an enforcement order.
- 4. Mail was reviewed.

- 6. Reynolds made a motion to research the cost and possible donors for a camera and surveyors tape to be used on site visits. Forbes seconded this motion, which was unanimously approved. Cannavo offered to donate her surveyors tape.
- 7. There followed discussion of logging along Rice Brook on the property of Brad Rice, which was brought to the attention of the Commission. Harker made a motion to write a letter to the property owner notifying him of the regulations regarding such activity. This was unanimously approved. As an abutter, Forbes recused himself from the discussion.
- 8. Harker mentioned that Mike Walsh has shown interest in joining the Commission if a vacancy should arise.
- 9. Harker made a motion to make the Secretary to Boards the Conservation Commission clerk and treasurer. This was unanimously approved.
- 10. Harker proposed the idea of a "policy booklet" that would explain protocol for site visits, sign-offs and other procedures.
- 11. It was determined that commissioners should report site visits completed, mileage, and permits approved to Carlene Hayden.
