## CHARLEMONT FINANCE COMMITTEE

Minutes of Meeting: May 8, 2010, 8:30 a.m.

Present: Norma Lynch, Richard Filoramo, Ted Willard, Amy Wales, Camille White Selectman Winston Healy

- 1. The Minutes of May 1, 2010 were approved and signed.
- 2. <u>Library</u>. After discussion, it was <u>VOTED</u> to fund the Library budget as requested.
- 3. <u>Employee Compensation.</u> T. Willard recused himself from Committee discussion of employee compensation.
- 4. River Patrols. The Committee VOTED 3 to 2 in favor of funding this line item.
- 5. <u>Highway Budget.</u> Gordon Hathaway, Highway Superintendent, met with the Committee and after further discussion and explanation, it was <u>VOTED</u> to fund the Highway Department budget as requested.
- 6. <u>Technical Schools.</u> It was <u>VOTED</u> to fund Technical Schools at \$138,000; six at \$15,000, one at \$18,000, two extra at \$15,000. It was further <u>VOTED</u> to fund Technical School Transportation at \$36,000.
- 7. <u>Animal Inspection.</u> The Committee <u>VOTED</u> to recommend the new budget line item "Animal Inspection Expenses" added to the budget by the Board of Selectmen funded in the amount of \$1,200.
- 8. <u>Employee Health Insurance.</u> Following discussion, it was <u>VOTED</u> to recommend to the Board of Selectmen the employee share of health insurance be increased to 25% and to adjust salaries to compensate. The Town share of health insurance will be decreased accordingly. It was further <u>VOTED</u> to budget health insurance for six employees.
- 9. Open Space Warrant Article. It was VOTED to not recommend this article.
- 10. <u>Mohawk Stabilization Warrant Article</u>. A. Wales recused herself from discussion. It was VOTED to not recommend this article.
- 11. It was agreed N. Lynch would meet at a mutually agreeable time with W. Healy and Kathy Reynolds, Executive Secretary, to clarify several budget line items.
- 12. It was also agreed available FinCom members will meet with the Board of Selectmen at 7:15 p.m., Tuesday, May 18, to present and explain the budget.
- 13. All FinCom members having completed the <u>Ethics Test</u>, it was <u>VOTED</u> to remove this item from Old Business.

The next meeting was scheduled for 8:30 a.m. Saturday, May 22, 2010.

The meeting adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
